Passenger Activity

59 flights in January 2011.

Mr. Conner reported on the "Airport Quick Look" charts, passenger enplanements for the month of January 2013 decreased 1.7% to 16,437 from 16,715 in the month of January 2012. Mr. Conner noted that this is attributable to the loss of a daily Delta flight to Detroit for the winter season.		
Enplanements for January 2013 compared to enplanements for January 2011 decreased by 300 or 1.8%. This is mainly attributable to the loss of American Eagle's

	Enplanements for January 2013 compared to enplanements decreased by 131 or 0.8%. This is mainly attributable to the flight to Newark.		
	In January 2013, 30 departing flights were cancelled: 26 for mechanical. This accounts for 1,324 seats (5.8%) out of a tot seats. Also, 31 arriving flights were cancelled: 28 for air traf mechanical.	al 24,3	44 departure

DISCUSSION:	For January 2013, General Aviation had 618 operations (one take-off or one landing which is a decrease of 21% from January 2012's 780 General Aviation Operations. General Aviation revenues decreased \$ 2,843.48 or 41% to \$ 4,148.25.

After review of all submissions, Airport Administration interviewed four (4) brokers. Considering each brokers' capabilities, their understanding of the Airports' insurance needs, and price for their services, Kincel & Company is recommended for a two (2) year contract, with a one (1) year extension option, at an annual fee of \$ 10,500.00 per year. Kincel & Company's price for services is the lowest of all the interviewed brokers and the company has a positive track record with the Airport for reducing premium costs and servicing our accounts. 	Access Road and I-81 Interchange.
	The following Easements and Waiver of Rights Agreements are related to PennDOT's construction of the Interstate 81 Interchange Project and the Roadway Construction Project leading from the new interchange at Navy Way Road to the Industrial Parks on the East Side of the Pennsylvania Turnpike. The land parcels being eased to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for these projects were surveyed and appraised by PennDOT and Airport consultants, with the fair market value of the land being paid to the Airport in the cases where a monetary transaction will take place. In the cases where no monetary transaction will take place, or where the consideration is \$1.00, these land parcels become part of the Airport's share of the project, as previously agreed by the Airport and PennDOT.

## Temporary Easement for Construction Purposes #1

Request the Airport Board approve the Temporary Easement for Construction Purposes for claim #4000475000, between the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, subject to FAA and Solicitors approval, for the easement of 9.924 acres of land adjacent to the PennDOT SR PORT – AIR project for the purpose of temporary roadway construction and work areas. Monetary consideration for this easement will be \$1.00. The term of this easement is two (2) years from the date of notice to proceed to the construction contractor.

#### Agreement of Sale (Purchase Property Easement) #2

Request the Airport Board approve the Agreement of Sale (Property Easement) for claim #4000535000, between the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, subject to FAA and Solicitors approval, for the easement of a 3.467 acre parcel of property for the purpose of PennDOT constructing the SR 81 project which includes the construction of the new highway interchange from Interstate 81 adjacent to the Airport. Monetary consideration for this parcel will be \$118,000.

#### Deed of Easement #2

Request the Airport Board approve the Deed of Easement for claim #4000475000, between the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, subject to FAA and Solicitors approval, for the easement of a 3.467 acre parcel of property for the purpose of PennDOT constructing the SR 81 project which includes the construction of the new highway interchange from Interstate 81 adjacent to the Airport. Monetary consideration for this Deed will be \$1.00.

## Temporary Easement for Construction Purposes #2

Request the Airport Board approve the Temporary Easement for Construction Purposes for claim #4000535000, between the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, subject to FAA and Solicitors approval, for the easement of 0.313 acre of land adjacent to the PennDOT SR 81 project for the purpose of temporary roadway construction and work areas. Monetary consideration for this easement will be \$2,200. The term of this easement is two (2) years from the date of notice to proceed to the construction contractor.

## Waiver of Rights Agreement.

Request the Airport Board approve the Waiver of Rights Agreement for claim #4000475000, between the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, subject to FAA and Solicitors approval. The Agreement waives the Airports rights to \$ 531,000.00, which is the just compensation for the Airport owned property eased to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the construction of the access road from Navy Way to the Industrial Parks east of the Pennsylvania Turnpike. The Airport originally pledged the property costs as our share of the cost to construct the access road on our property.

Mr. Centini also told the Board that the FAA notice in the Federal Register regarding Release of Aeronautical Property at the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport was attached for their info. He also stated that comment period ends 3/1/2013, therefore the approval of all the above easements would coincide with an FAA approval to move forward.
